Located in Fort Mitchell, Kentucky, Vent Haven Museum is the only museum in the world dedicated to the art and history of ventriloquism. The museum was originally a private collection assembled by Cincinnati native William Shakespeare "W.S." Berger, and was opened to the public on June 30, 1973.

Each year, tourists from around the world come to see the 800+ ventriloquists' dummies on display. Tourists learn the history of Vent Haven Museum, see demonstrations of some of the dummies and puppets, watch video clips and have plenty of photo opportunities.

The museum hosts an annual international convention. Over 600 ventriloquists attend each year.
